- 1 Title: A Bill to Amend Article 7 of the Constitution and Sections 7-1(c) and 7-10 of the
- 2 Statutory Code to Eliminate the Provisions for Indefinite Suspension of a Member
- 3 **Proposed by:** The Committee on Constitution
- 4 Endorsed by: The Grand High Zeta, the Student Advisory Committee, and the Office of
- 5 Administration
- 6 Referred to: Legislative Committee 5. The Legislative Committee has determined to
- 7 report on Bill No. 6 FAVORABLY.
- 8 Vote Required: Three-fourths of votes cast
- 9 Rationale: Among the penalties that can be imposed in member disciplinary
- actions are suspension for a definite period, suspension for an indefinite period,
- 11 and expulsion. There is no practical difference between suspension for an
- 12 indefinite period and expulsion. The existence of the concept of indefinite
- suspension causes confusion in the penalty phase of member disciplinary
- 14 actions.
- 15 This bill proposes that that the concept of **indefinite suspension** be eliminated
- from our laws, so a member may be suspended only for a definite period (e.g.,
- 17 ending on a date certain or when he ceases to be engaged in a course of
- 18 undergraduate study) or be expelled. If the conduct were so egregious that the
- 19 Chapter did not believe the member should become an Alumni Member in
- 20 good standing after graduation, the penalty would be expulsion, not indefinite
- 21 suspension.

- 22 Be it Enacted that Article 7, Section 3 of the Constitution of the Lambda Chi Alpha
- 23 Fraternity and Sections 7-1(c) and 7-10 of the Statutory Code of the Lambda Chi
- 24 Alpha Fraternity be amended as follows:
  - Article 7, Section 3. Penalties. A Member found guilty of an offense against the Fraternity shall be subject to one or more of the following penalties: (a) expulsion (not applicable to an Associate Member), (b) disassociation (applicable only to an Associate Member), (c) suspension for a designated period for either an indefinite period or a definite period, (d) probation, (e) fine, (f) censure, or (g) other lawful penalty.
- 31 Code 7-1(c). Penalties Defined.
  - c. Suspension. A <u>suspended</u> Member <u>shall:</u> may be suspended for an <u>indefinite period</u> or a <u>definite period</u>.
    - 1. Indefinite period. A Member suspended for an indefinite period shall:
      - 1.(a) Remove himself and his personal effects from the property of the Chapter and he shall not return for any purpose unless expressly permitted to do so by the Executive Committee.

The petition shall contain a narrative history of the Member and his association with the Fraternity, the circumstances of his expulsion or suspension, and the reasons for application of reinstatement. Upon receipt of a petition for reinstatement, the Executive Committee of the Chapter shall within ten (10) regular business days present to the Chapter: |

from Members knowledgeable about the facts of the case. The petitioning Member shall be allowed to attend the hearing and orally present his petition; however, he shall not be present during the voting. All Collegiate Brothers and Associate Members in good standing are entitled to vote at the meeting, but there shall be no voting by proxy. In the matter of reinstatement from expulsion, a three-fourths favorable vote of those present and voting is necessary for reinstatement either in full or for a lesser disciplinary status. In the matter of reinstatement from indefinite-suspension, a majority favorable vote of those present and voting is necessary for reinstatement either in full or for a lesser disciplinary status. The decision of the Chapter, whether favorable or unfavorable, along with a copy of the petition shall be provided to the Chapter's High Pi (or the Grand High Pi, as appropriate) and one copy shall be forwarded to the General Fraternity by the Chapter's secretary. If the vote is unfavorable, the expelled Member may not re-present his petition for a period of at least one calendar year, and the suspended Member may not re-present his petition for a period of at least 180 calendar days. The Grand High Zeta may, in extraordinary circumstances, order any expelled or suspended Member reinstated in full or reinstated and placed on a lesser disciplinary status.

- b. An Associate Member disassociated from the Fraternity may be reassociated only as provided for in Code 4-3 of this *Statutory Code* and subject to conditions in Code 4-6 of this *Statutory Code*.
- c. Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of Code 7-10(a) or (b) above, any application for reinstatement from suspension or expulsion <u>imposed</u> <u>by arising out of</u> a Control Board authorized under Code 7-7 of this Statutory Code, must be made to <u>the chairman of the Alumni Control Board</u>, or, in his absence, to the Grand High Pi.

Be it Further Enacted, that conforming changes are approved to any and all other related provisions of the *Constitution* of the Lambda Chi Alpha Fraternity and/or the *Statutory Code* of the Lambda Chi Alpha Fraternity made necessary by reason of this amendment.
